**The Freshman Accelerated Fresh Start (FAFS) Policy:** FAFS is an opportunity available for first-time, first-year students who finish their first semester at CSU with a GPA below 1.000.

1. Students who meet the above criteria will have the following option:

- Leave the University for 1 – 3 semesters (the summer session is not included in this count). Any student not ready to return after 1-3 semesters has the option to wait and return under standard Fresh Start. [Scholastic Standard details online.](#)
- Reapply/return to CSU and begin earning a new cumulative GPA (first semester grades remain on the student's transcript but will not be calculated in their cumulative GPA).
- To return, a student must complete a returning student application accompanied by supplemental documentation that addresses a combination of factors, including evidence of maturity and/or academic success at another institution as well as their strengthened preparation for academic success at CSU (this form).
